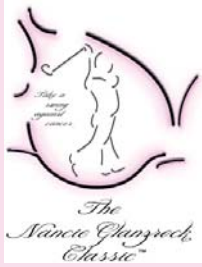

While some of you don't know Nancie, you know someone who has endured cancer, survived it, or ultimately joined the angels in the sky who faithfully watch over us. Like your loved ones, Nancie is your sister, your advocate, the silent, anonymous angel making sure the needs of others are met. She's a beautiful soul who would give anything to anyone in need, and it's her time of need. However, true to Nancie's spirit, she wants a day that brings a broader awareness to reach beyond her plight. The Nancie Glanzrock Classic is a day dedicated to everyone touched by cancer. A day of hope, remembrance and celebration of those who have waged and are waging the good battle and those who stand by their side, valiantly wielding the sword of love, protection and support.

Nancie has left an indelible imprint on the heart of every person she had met. She has spent a lifetime in service to her communities. After surviving her first battle with cancer in 2003-04, Nancie recognized the importance of living a full life. She also learned the importance of keeping a close eye on her health. Given her proactive dedication to monitoring her health, in October 2008, she visited the doctor given an irregularity in self examination. The doctors discovered a tumor and she was diagnosed with Stage IV Metastatic Breast Cancer. Given the location of the tumor, the doctors decided to start treatment with chemotherapy and radiation hoping to reduce the size of the tumor.

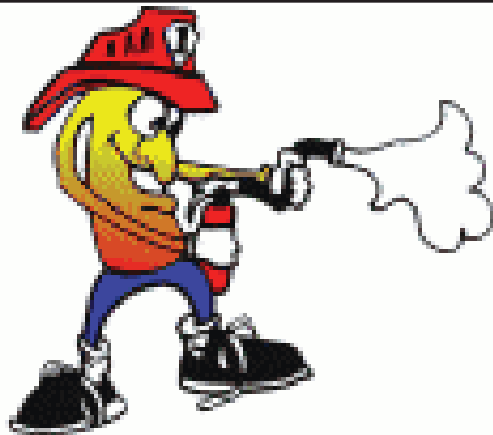
In April 2009, the doctors decided to remove the tumor, which required an invasive chest surgery that involved removing 3 ribs and part of her sternum and reconstruction of the chest wall. This was the start of an arduous journey. Nancie has endured infections, open wounds, wound vac installation, infusions, more surgeries, chemo, hyperbaric oxygen treatments, and travel to Tucson, UCLA, and MD Anderson in Houston for treatment. Since 2008, Nancie has maintained her optimism through:

- 4 surgeries
- over 50 cycles of chemotherapy
- well over 200 rounds of chemotherapy
- countless tests and weekly blood draws
- 4 thoracentesis procedures
- Extended medical treatment in facilities in 3 different states

Through it all, Nancie has valiantly waged the good fight and has kept her sights on the finish line - to be cancer free. She's not there yet, but through the tumultuous years, with the dedicated support of medical staff, friends and family, she has maintained faith that she can cross that finish line. While the physical and emotional toll has been extreme, the financial toll of the nearly 3 years of cancer treatment has been equally steep. This tournament was brought to you by individuals who care deeply about Nancie. Each one of us has been touched by someone with cancer. It is our honor to celebrate and remember all of those individuals today.

We have been overwhelmed by everyone's generosity and inspired to see a community of volunteers contributing when they are needed most.
